

CODE OF DISCIPLINE FOR WATER POLO

Based on CEEA General Event Rule E 20.1 the following **CODE OF DISCIPLINE** shall apply for all **CEEA WATER POLO ACTIVITIES**

1. GENERAL

1.1 Disciplinary action on individuals and/or teams may be taken by the CEEA Technical Water Polo Committee Executive and/or the CEEA Delegate(s) present at a CEEA Water Polo Event or an international friendly tournament agreed beforehand on the CEEA Calendar.

1.2 The CEEA Secretary shall be informed about any disciplinary action decided according to paragraph 1.1 and take further action if necessary.

1.3 Suspension(s) from one or more water polo matches may be imposed on:

a) Players:

All Water Polo players who are listed on a line-up of a team or match-card at a Water Polo match played under the jurisdiction of CEEA, before, during and after the respective match.

b) Officials:

All those persons who are listed on the line-up of a Water Polo match played under the jurisdiction of CEEA or who accompany a team.

c) CEEA Officials:

All those persons nominated by CEEA to act as delegates, referees, goal judges as well as all officials on the table for any Water Polo match played under the jurisdiction of CEEA.

d) Supporters:

All those persons supporting a particular club, whether or not they form part as members of that club, are to be considered as supporters of that particular club before, during and after the match.

1.4 Suspensions imposed are to be served in the next water polo matches under the control of CEEA in the same category in which the offence has been committed, such as:

- a. international matches between National Senior Teams of Federations, or;
- b. international matches between National Under 20 Teams of Federations, or;
- c. international matches between National Junior Teams of Federations, or;
- d. CEEA club competitions.

2 OFFENCES BY PLAYERS IN CONFRONTATION AGAINST OTHER PLAYERS

	Kind of offence	Sanction
2.1	Violence, brutality, aggressive ness or acts of misbehaviour:	one (1) to a maximum of five (5) matches according to the gravity of the case.

3 OFFENCES BY TEAM OFFICIALS AND TEAMS

	Kind of offence	Sanction
3.1	Teams are not allowed to make use of team officials who are under contract with other teams or Federations:	Fine up to EURO 500.—for teams making use of ineligible team officials.
3.2	Teams making use of ineligible players:	Teams will lose that or those matches played with ineligible players and will be suspended from participating further in that competition. Should such a default occur at the end of the competition, the suspension could be extended for the next CEEA competition for which it is qualified.
3.3	A team forfeiting one (1) or more matches:	The team shall be totally disqualified and all the results cancelled. In cases of "force majeure" interfering with the staging of a match, the Technical Delegate in charge shall decide. Where a team is disqualified for one (1) or more matches these shall be awarded to the opposing teams concerned with a score of 10:0.
3.4	More than three members of the same team, including team officials, commit offences referred to in articles 2.1, 3.1 and/or 3.2:	The team shall be sanctioned with disqualification from that match and a minimum suspension from the next match in the tournament to a maximum suspension for a period of one (1) year. Suspension of match or matches referred to in paragraph 3.4 means that the opponent(s) of the team suspended shall be awarded with a win with a goal score of 10:0.

4 OFFENCES AGAINST PLAYERS, OFFICIALS OF TEAMS OR SPECTATORS

	Kind of offence	Sanction
4.1	Grave Injuries:	Up to one (1) year
4.2	Using any hard object such as wood, bottle, shoes, etc.:	Not less than three (3) matches and not more than six (6) matches.
4.3	Using any other object such as slippers, ball, etc.:	Not less than two (2) matches and not more than five (5) matches.
4.4	Using any kind of violence (including throwing officials in water or pulling in any part of their bodies)	Not less than one (1) match and not more than three (3) matches.
4.5	Aggression or Misbehaviour (such as splashing water, shouting names, threatening, etc.):	Not less than one (1) match and not more than two (2) matches.
4.6	Insolence, Low Gestures and Remarks, etc.:	Not less than one (1) match and not more than two (2) matches.

5 VIOLENCE BY SUPPORTERS

	Kind of offence	Sanctions
5.1	Any acts of violence, aggressiveness, threatening, spitting and general misbehaviour:	The team is to be fined up to EURO 2000.—and suspended from playing at home for up to two (2) matches.
5.2	If the offence is of a grave nature and of some consequence:	The team is to be fined up to EURO 3000.—and suspended from playing home for up to four (4) matches and up to four (4) points is to be deducted if that should be the case.

6 OFFENCES AGAINST CEEA OFFICIALS

	Kind of offence	Sanctions
6.1	Grave injuries:	Indefinite period.
6.2	Using any hard object such as wood, glass bottle (or plastic bottles filled with water), shoes, etc.:	Not less than one (1) year up to a maximum of three (3) years.
6.3	Using any other hard object such as slipper, ball, etc.:	Not less than four (4) months and not more than two (2) years
6.4	Using any kind of violence (including throwing officials in water or pulling in any part of their bodies):	Not less than six (6) months and not more than one (1) year.
6.5	Attempt of violence as stated above:	Not less than three (3) matches up to a maximum suspension for one (1) year.
6.6	Aggression or misbehavior (such as splashing water, shouting names, threatening, etc.)	Reprimand and/or suspension of up to three (3) matches.
6.7	Disapproval, Insolence, Low, Gestures and Remarks, etc.:	Reprimand and/or suspension of up to two (2) matches.

7. OFFENCES BY CEEA OFFICIALS

7.1 The sanctions to be imposed for offences committed by any person appointed by CEEA as per paragraph 1.3 of this code of discipline shall be suspension from participating further in the tournament in which the offence occurred.

7.2 A report shall be submitted to the CEEA Bureau for further consideration or additional disciplinary action if necessary.

8. OTHER OFFENCES

8.1 Any other offences not included in this code of discipline including offences against media representatives will be dealt with as deemed fit within the spirit of the above disciplinary measures.

8.2 If an offence referred to in this code of discipline is committed by any person other than a player or team official, the minimum sanction shall be a warning or exclusion from the venue up

to a maximum sanction of suspension of the right to attend CEEA Water Polo matches for any period up to and including life
