

CEEA ARTISTIC SWIMMING JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

REGULATIONS

shall apply

1 ORGANISATION

1.1. The Championships shall be held every year.

1.2. The organising Member and the place where the Championships shall be held shall be decided by the CEEA Bureau and circulated by the CEEA Office.

1.3. The Commission (Bureau Liaison, TSSC Chairman, TSSC Vice-Chairman and TSSC Hon. secretary) shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation and the correct conduct of the competitions according to CEEA Rules and regulations. The Commission shall decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

2 EVENTS & PARTICIPATION

2.1. Age Group:

a) Under 12 years(10-12)

b) Juniors(B) – 13-15 years

c) Juniors(A) – 16-18 years (competitors younger than fifteen (15) years of age (on December 31st on the year of the competition) shall not be permitted to compete in this age group)

2.2 Events are ,

-Under 12 years FINA compulsory and Solo Free Routine, Duet Free Routine, Mixed Duet Free Routine, Team Free Routine, Free Combination and Thematic Duett, Thematic Team

- Juniors B – 13-15 years FINA compulsory and Solo Free Routine, Duet Free Routine, Mixed Duet Free Routine, Team Free Routine, Free Combination and Thematic Duett, Thematic Team

- Junior A – 16-18 years Solo Technical Routine, Solo Free Routine, Duet Technical Routine, Duet Free Routine, Mixed Duet Technical Routine, Mixed Duet Free Routine, Team Technical Routine, Team Free Routine, Free Combination, Highlight Routine , Thematic Duett, Thematic Team

2.3 Members may submit entries for:

a) one (1) Solo Technical with one (1) reserve

b) one (1) Solo Free with one (1) reserve

c) one (1) Duet Technical with maximum one (1) reserve

d) one (1) Duet Free with maximum one (1) reserve

e) one (1) Mixed Duet Technical

f) one (1) Mixed Duet Free

g) one (1) Team Technical of four (4) to eight (8) members with maximum four (4) reserves

h) one (1) Team Free of four (4) to eight (8) members with maximum four (4) reserves

i) one (1) Free Combination of six (6) to ten (10) members with maximum two (2) reserves

j) one (1) Highlight Routine of eight (8) to ten (10) members with maximum two (2) reserves

2.4. The maximum number of athletes is twelve (12). If there is an entry for Mixed Duet the maximum number is fourteen (14).

3 FORMAT

3.1. Each event is calculated separately: Solo Technical 100%,

Duet Technical 100%, Mixed Duet Technical 100%, Team Technical 100%, Solo Free 100%, Duet Free 100%, Mixed Duet Free 100%, Team Free 100% , Free Combination 100%, Highlight Routine 100%.

3.2. If there are more than twelve (12) entires in Solo Free or Duet Free, the preliminaries will be held.

3.4. Free Solos and Free Duets ranked 1st to 12th after Solo Free Preliminary and Duet Free Preliminary shall qualify for Solo Free Final and Duet Free Final.

3.5. The composition of Duets, Teams, Free Combination and Highlight Routine shall be declared no later than two hours before the commencement of the session in which the event shall take place.

3.6. Withdrawls from any Finals shall be announced no later than one (1) hour after the end of the Prelimiaries concerned, otherwise they shall be fined (See Rule E 17.6.)

4 ENTRIES

5 ACCREDITATION

6 AWARDS

6.1. Medals shall be awarded for each event to the competitors placed first, second and third.

6.2. Diplomas shall be awarded to the competitors placed first to eight.

7 OFFICIALS

7.1 In addition to the Commission the CEEA TSSC shall nominate one (1) Referee, one (1) Assistant Referee and two (2) Evaluators.

7.2. – 7.3 As in the present rules

7.4. For each session the CEEA TSSC Commision shall nominate the judges panels and other officials.

7.5. Acting judges shall be evaluated.
